Who Can Submit

SBS welcomes submissions from pharmaceutical companies, researchers and technology providers. Abstracts should be scientific, original and noncommercial in nature, and should address cutting-edge research, experiments, new techniques, processes or procedures. Authors may include photographs, charts, or diagrams to support the research.

Submission Process

Abstracts and supporting documents must be submitted by email to: Jenna Ferber at **jenna@livderm.org** by January 9th, 2023.

Poster Preparation:

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Posters should be no larger than 4 feet high x 8 feet wide. The pin boards that the posters will be mounted on are 4 feet high x 8 feet wide, please make your poster smaller than those dimensions to allow for easy pinning. Please ensure that your poster is mounted on the correct poster board which will be numbered for your convenience.

Posters must be submitted via email along with the application and fee above to **jenna@livderm.org**

Submission Guidelines

Abstracts for poster entries must be submitted by January 9th, 2023 and can only be accepted electronically via email. Abstracts **must be fewer than**

400 words and adhere to the following guidelines:

- Organization: The body of the abstract should be organized into the following six sections: (1) Title,
 (2) Author(s), (3) Synopsis, (4) Objective/Purpose, (5) Methods, (6) Results, and (7) Conclusion
- Avoid Commercialism: No trade names should be used for drugs, devices, and/or instrumentation including lasers. Any medications or other substances referred to in the materials must be identified by their scientific names only.
- Disclosure: All authors must disclose any financial relationships – this includes lead and secondary authors.

Poster Display Information:

Posters will be displayed for the entirety of the meeting, from **Thursday, February 9th at 8am to ET to Sunday, February 12th at 12pm ET.** The posters will be on display in the Poster Abstract Gallery at the Loews Hotel as well as on the Virtual Platform for the SBS Meeting.

There is no official poster review session. The posters will be on display throughout the weekend for meeting attendees to view at their leisure until the end of the meeting on Sunday. If your poster is not taken down by Sunday at noon, we will discard the poster so please make sure to make plans to take it down if you would like to save the poster. Please ensure that your poster is submitted in the proper format and size.

Abstract Submission Fee:

All applications must be ac nonrefundable \$2,000 fee p	companied by a mandatory per abstract submission.
